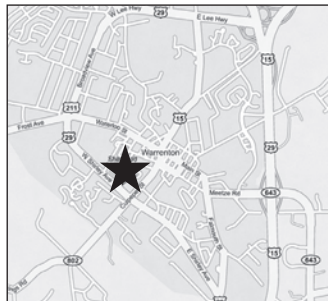

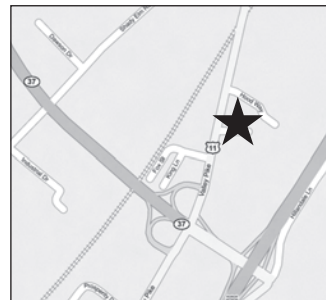

General Registration Information

All Transfer Students

- Students who have completed course work at another college or university and wish to receive transfer credit at LFCC must take the following actions:
 - Submit a completed application for admission at <https://apply.vccs.edu>
 - Have official transcripts and a catalog or course descriptions sent directly from schools attended
 - Submit a Transcript Evaluation Request form, available from the Admissions and Records Office, or at <http://www.lfcc.edu/Students/index.shtm>
- Students ineligible to return to the last college attended must petition for admission in writing to the Admissions and Records Office a minimum of 30 days prior to general registration. The College will decide on each case and may impose special conditions for admittance.
- Decisions regarding placement testing for transfer students are dependent on prior collegiate work. Persons desiring additional information should see the 2008-09 Catalog or contact the Office of Student Success at 540-351-1507, Fauquier Campus, or 540-868-7110, Middletown Campus.

Application for Financial Aid

- A variety of financial aid packages are available for qualified part-time or full-time enrolled students, including Pell Grants, Academic Competitiveness Grants (ACG), Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants (SEOG), the College Scholarship Assistance Program (CSAP) and College work-study positions. Contact the Financial Aid Office at 540-351-1519, Fauquier Campus, 540-868-7130, Middletown Campus, or at finaid@lfcc.edu.
- Students must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the 2008-09 academic year. Since processing requires six to eight weeks, applications for financial aid should be submitted as soon as possible. To expedite processing, apply online at <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov>
- Financial Aid bookstore accounts will be open from Aug. 11 – 29, 2008. Please bring a copy of your “list view” class schedule, a photo ID, and your LFCC student ID number.

Auditing

- Auditing means enrolling in a course for which a student would neither receive credit nor be required to take examinations.
- Registration for audit status is confined to the period from the beginning date of the term/course to the last date to register late and must be approved by the faculty member and appropriate dean.
- Tuition and fees are applicable for audit classes.

Classroom or Instructor Changes

- LFCC reserves the right to change instructors or classroom delivery method (Web, classroom, independent study or distance education)

to accommodate class availability, size or structure without prior notice.

Course Cancellation

- LFCC may cancel courses not meeting minimum enrollment requirements.

Refunds

- Refunds will be made if a student drops the course by the appropriate deadline.

Senior Citizens

- Senior citizens are encouraged to take advantage of tuition-free* courses. Virginia citizens age 60 or older:

1) may enroll in credit courses for credit if their Virginia taxable income did not exceed \$15,000 for the preceding year, and

2) may enroll in credit courses for AUDIT (no credit) regardless of income. Senior citizens eligible for free tuition will register the day a session begins on a space-available basis at the Admissions and Records Office.

**Some classes have special fees. These fees are not a part of the senior citizen tuition waiver and will be charged.*

Disability Services

- LFCC is committed to serving students with disabilities. Students needing special services are urged to inquire about accommodations through the Office of Student Success at 540-351-1507, Fauquier Campus, or 540-868-7110, Middletown Campus.

Withdrawing from a Course(s)

- Requests to withdraw must be signed by the student and become effective the date received in the Admissions and Records Office. The course professor's signature, or the appropriate dean when the professor is not available, is required to withdraw from a course(s), unless withdrawing from all courses in which case a counselor's signature is required. Withdrawals after the last date to drop for each session must be processed by the Admission and Records Office.

Veterans' Benefits

- Any student wishing to receive veterans' educational benefits must notify the Veterans Affairs Officer each term. The U. S. Department of Veterans Affairs will only pay benefits for courses which are applicable to the student's approved program of study. Contact the Veterans Affairs Officer at 540-868-7073 for additional information.

Step-by-Step Registration for Credit Courses

1. Application

A completed application form must be submitted to the Admissions and Records Office by new students and formerly enrolled students who have not been enrolled since the 2005 summer term. Applications must be submitted prior to taking placement tests. Apply online at <https://apply.vccs.edu>. Students may also complete an application available at the Admissions and Records Office at the Fauquier and Middletown Campuses.

2. Placement Testing

- New students must take placement tests in English, reading and math. The results of the tests help students and advisers determine an appropriate course schedule. Students whose scores indicate specific weaknesses may be required to enroll in and successfully complete skill improvement courses prior to college course work.
- All students wishing to register for any English, reading or math courses or any courses with a reading prerequisite must complete placement testing prior to registration. Placement testing is computerized (you do not need special computer skills) and individualized (first-come, first-served basis). The test takes approximately two hours and 30 minutes. Individualized testing for students with special needs may be arranged with the Testing Center.
- A student who presents SAT scores of at least 500 critical reading, verbal and/or math from testing within the last five years is not required to take placement testing. SAT scores must be forwarded to the College's Testing Center directly from the College Board.
- Testing at the Middletown Campus has been scheduled during the times listed below. No special appointment is needed for students reporting during the scheduled periods listed. Students should plan to finish the test by the advertised closing time. Students unable to attend one of the dates listed are encouraged to contact the Testing Center at 540-868-7140 to schedule an individual appointment.

3. Orientation/Academic Advising

- **First-time Students** — First-time students registering for classes are encouraged to attend a New Student Orientation (NSO). Those students wishing to pursue degrees at the College are required to attend an orientation. The orientation is designed to help new students learn about the College and the registration process and will allow students to meet with advisers and register for classes for the upcoming semester. make an appointment to meet with their faculty adviser regularly regarding program requirements, progress toward graduation and any changes in the catalog.

5. Paying Tuition

- Students must pay tuition and fees for early registration before 4 p.m. on Wednesday, Aug. 6. Students who fail to pay tuition by Aug. 6 before 4 p.m. will have their registrations cancelled.
- When registering, Aug. 11 – 22, payment is due at time of registration.
- Registration is complete only when tuition has been paid.
- Payment may be made by cash, money order, Visa, MasterCard or personal check. Tuition payments may be made in person, mailed to the College's Business Office, paid by telephone or paid online at <http://www.lfcc.edu>. Payment may be made online with MasterCard or Visa. To pay tuition by telephone, contact the Business Office at 540-351-1508, Fauquier Campus and/or 540-868-7124/7118/7125/7127, Middletown Campus. To pay via telephone registration (IVR), dial 540-868-7241.
- Interest-Free FACTS Tuition Payment Plan: To help meet your educational expenses, LFCC is pleased to provide FACTS tuition payment plan. FACTS allows you to pay your tuition in monthly installments. The earlier you enroll, the more payment options you have. For more information, call FACTS at 800-609-8056.

6. Tuition Rates for Fall 2008

- **Tuition rates** are established by the State Board for Community Colleges and are subject to change. Tuition rates are indicated below:
 - In-State Students:\$81.65 per credit
 - Out-of-State Students:\$253.80 per credit
- **In-State Tuition:** To be eligible for in-state tuition rates, a student must have been legally domiciled in Virginia for a period of at least one full year prior to the planned semester of enrollment at the College. Domicile is a legal concept which means more than simple residency in Virginia. An individual seeking eligibility for in-state tuition must demonstrate the intention of remaining in Virginia indefinitely. For additional information about domicile requirements, contact the Admissions and Records Office.
- **Fees:** A student activity fee of \$1.15 per credit hour is charged to all students taking on-campus classes. Student activities fees fund various student activities and events throughout the school year. A parking facilities maintenance fee of \$14 per semester will be charged to all students enrolled in courses at the Fauquier and Middletown Campuses. The parking facilities maintenance fee is used to construct and maintain parking lots at both campuses. A technology fee of \$4.50 per credit hour will be charged to all students. The technology fee is used to help fund technology initiatives for classrooms. Out-of-state students will be assessed a \$3 capital fee per credit hour. A \$20 fee is assessed for returned checks. Contractual billings are assessed late payment fees at 18 percent per annum.

7. Class Attendance Required

The VCCS Policy Manual states in 5.6.0 that in order to receive any letter grade, a student must have attended a minimum of one class meeting or the equivalent in the case of a distance learning course. In a distance learning course, initial student attendance is determined by course participation as measured by accessing and using course materials, completion of a class assignment, participation in a course discussion or other evidence of participation. Students who enroll in a course but do not attend a minimum of one class meeting or the distance learning equivalent by the census date or earlier date as defined and published by the institution must be administratively dropped from the course by the college. Existing college policies regarding tuition refund shall remain in effect.

8. Financial Aid Students: Refunds and Repayments

Federal financial aid regulations require the College to refund a portion of the tuition and fees paid by or on behalf of a federal financial aid recipient, if he/she withdraws completely during a semester. Regulations also require a student to repay to financial aid programs some of the funds received, if he/she was not enrolled long enough during the semester to qualify for the amount received.

9. Bookstore Purchases

- A separate payment is required for bookstore purchases. Payment may be made at the bookstore using American Express, Discover, MasterCard or Visa credit cards. Visit the bookstore online at <http://www.lfcc.edu/directory/bkstorhr.shtm>.
- Financial Aid bookstore accounts will be open from Aug. 11 through 29, 2008. Please bring a copy of your "list view" class schedule, a photo ID and your LFCC student ID number.

- Are not registering to audit a class

WHEN: Early registration for fall 2008 classes will be held

Students registering Aug. 11 through 22 must pay tuition at the time of registration. Financial Aid Information

Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)

To be eligible to receive financial aid or scholarships at LFCC, students are required to make satisfactory academic progress toward successful completion of the program of study to which they have been admitted.

Some SAP Facts

- Grades of **F**, **U**, **W** or **X** hurt your progress equally.
- This rule applies even if you did not receive financial aid previously.
- SAP standards are tougher than the College academic standing rules.
- Academic renewal does not automatically reinstate your financial aid eligibility.

How to Keep Your Financial Aid

To remain eligible for grants and work-study, you should:

- Finish the classes you start and avoid withdrawing and grades of **F**, **U**, **W** or **X**.
- Complete the FAFSA each year before May 1.

Satisfactory Academic Progress Standards

- **Completion Rate**—A student must successfully complete two-thirds (67 percent) of all the credit and developmental hours they attempt. Completion rates will be assessed at the point a student has attempted 13 hours. Successful completion means a grade of A, B, C, D,

S, R or P. Grades of F, U, W, X and missing grades represent hours not completed. Federal law requires the College to count all credits attempted at the College.

- **Maximum Time Frame**—The U.S. Department of Education expects students to complete their plan requirements within 150 percent of the published length of that plan in credit hours. Developmental/ESL hours do not count in this total. For example, a student in the Associate of Applied Science Degree in Accounting (length 66 hours) will lose their eligibility after 99 attempted hours if they have not finished the plan. Students can calculate their own 150 percent rate by finding the total credits in their plan from the catalog.

$$\text{Total Plan Credits} \times 1.5 = \text{Your Maximum}$$

- **Grade Point Average (GPA)**—Students must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0 after completing 12 credit hours to be eligible for aid. Some scholarships have stricter GPA requirements.

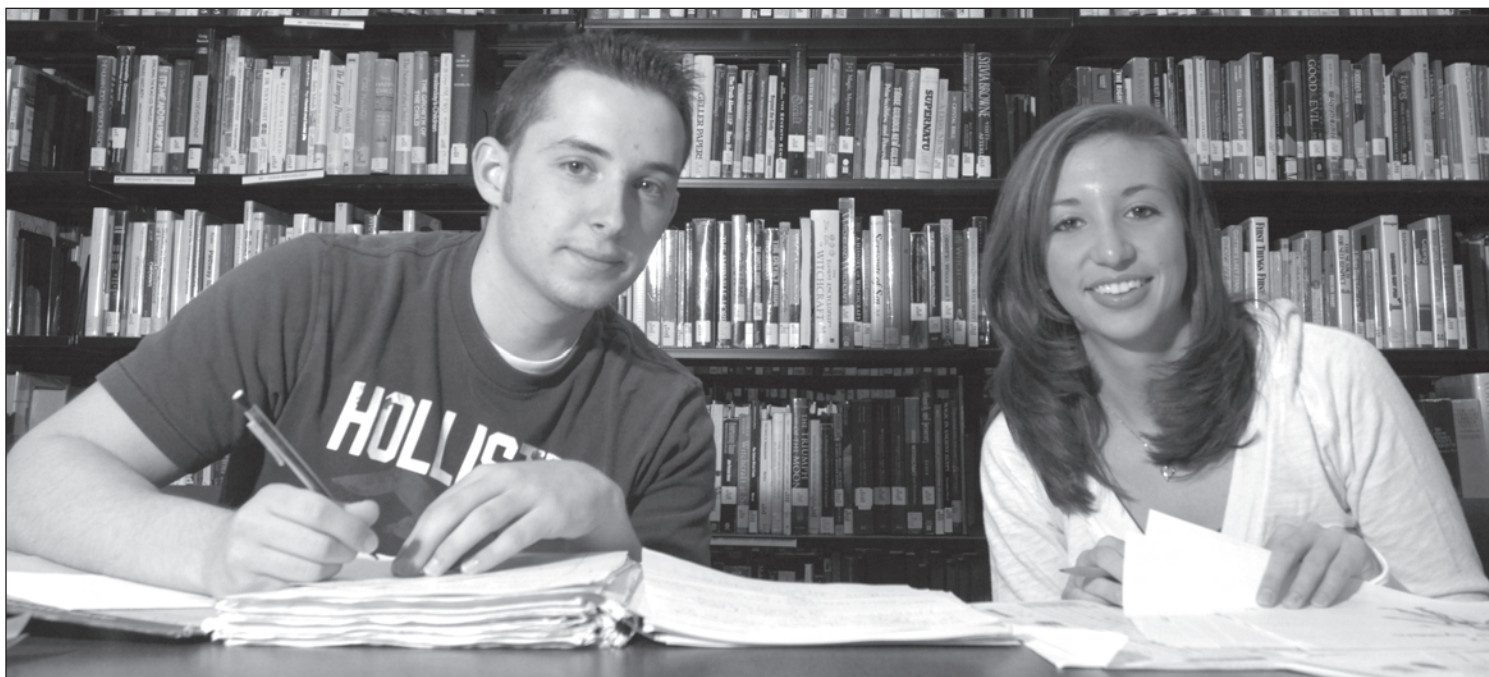
If You Do Not Meet the Standards:

Assessment—The Financial Aid Office checks each student's eligibility at the end of each semester and cancels future aid for students who do not meet the SAP standards.

Notification—The Financial Aid Office will notify students of their status by placing a message on their MY LFCC account or by mailing letters to students.

Appeal—Students with mitigating circumstances (personal illness, death of immediate family member, etc.) that occurred during the problem semester(s) may submit an appeal letter to the Financial Aid Office.

Stay Informed—Students should work closely with their academic adviser and choose their classes wisely. Also, contact or meet with the Financial Aid staff with any questions or concerns.
