
Useful Information

Students may complete the degree after admission to Radford University by taking remaining courses at Lord Fairfax Community College, or as a result of credits earned at Radford University, up to a limit of 10 credit hours.


Admission to Radford University. Students completing this degree at Lord Fairfax Community College with a cumulative grade point average of 2.800 and who have earned a grade of "C" or higher in each course applicable to this degree will be guaranteed admission to Radford University under the terms of the Guaranteed Admission Agreement between the Virginia Community College System and Radford University. Students who do not meet the eligibility requirements for guaranteed admission may still apply through the regular admission procedures.
