



Information Literacy Assessment for Spring 2023 Graduates

Hello, soon-to-be Laurel Ridge graduates!

Between March 29 and May 3, all students who have applied for spring graduation must complete an Information Literacy Assessment. **This does not impact any course grades or your GPA but should be completed by all graduates.** Instructions for completing this assessment are below.

You will need to take this assessment in a quiet place with enough time to thoughtfully answer all questions. The [Academic Honesty Pledge ▶ Laurel Ridge Community College](#) applies to this assessment. You may not collaborate with others.

The test can be taken on a laptop, desktop, tablet, or phone. Please note: A phone is not optimal, because there are reading passages that may be difficult to see on a small screen, but it does still work with those limitations.

Prior to starting the assessment, you will need to **disable pop-up blockers** on your device's web browser, or the assessment may not work properly.

TEST ADMINISTRATION STEPS:

1. Go to this website:

2. In the middle of the login page, click on the link that says **Need to create a new user account?**
3. Enter your Name, create a **Login (user name)**, enter your **Student Email address**, and create a **Password**.
4. Click on the **Create New User** button at bottom of page.
5. Enter your **Student ID #**.
6. Enter Laurel Ridge Community College as your **Testing Location (college)**.

7. Click the **Update Required Information** button.
8. Read the instructions.
9. Click the **Start Taking this Test** button.
10. Take the test.
11. After answering the last question, review score.
12. Click **Click here to close this window**.
13. Close browser.

****Special note about website URLs:*** *Your browser might force the assessment URL provided above to span across multiple lines. URLs begin with string 'http'. URLs CANNOT contain a blank space. URLs that span across multiple lines end at the start of the blank line (start of a new carriage return). If you copy and paste the URL, make sure you get the entire URL if it spans across multiple lines and remove any blanks or carriage returns added by your application.*
