



Nursing, AAS (RN) Application Checklist

The following is intended as a general guideline to ensure applicants have completed the necessary steps to apply to the Nursing, AAS (RN) program. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that all items arrive prior to the published deadline. Late application materials will make the applicant ineligible. Please understand that an applicant may have unique circumstances, which may require further documentation or verification, in which case the applicant may be asked to furnish additional information.

All applicants must:

- Be an admitted Laurel Ridge student.
- Be a high school graduate or equivalent (prior to starting program).
- Complete each required prerequisite course with a grade of "C" or better.
- Earn a curricular GPA of 2.5 or higher in the specific prerequisite courses.
- Meet math eligibility by completion of MDE 10 or have eligibility to enroll in MTH 154.
- Attest to possessing basic computer competencies.
- Complete the HESI A2 exam with scores at or above the required minimum scores.

Document Requirements:

- **Official** High school transcript or GED certificate – must be submitted to admissions@laurelridge.edu.
- International transcripts must be translated and evaluated for high school equivalency by a professional organization or agency that is a member of the National Association of Credential Evaluators.
- Unofficial Laurel Ridge academic transcript.
- Unofficial academic transcript from each Virginia Community College System (VCCS) attended.
- **Official** academic transcript from other colleges attended if completed course work is applicable to the [Nursing, AAS \(RN\)](#) prerequisites or academic requirements – must be submitted to records@laurelridge.edu
 - Transfer Credits: Applicants are responsible for ensuring that official transcripts are submitted to the Laurel Ridge Records Office for transfer credit evaluation before applying.
